

# UNDERSTANDING THE NEW DQRs

When reviewing the assessment detail tab, note that each client has two rows. These rows correspond to the two rows in the header. In the example below, the first row shows that the client Date of Birth is **Ok**, while the second row shows that the Approximate Date Started is left empty. We can see this is correct by referring to the entry/exit in ClientPoint and seeing that the Approximate Date Started is, in fact, empty. We have included a list of the abbreviations used in the Assessment Detail for your convenience.

**Assessment Abbreviations**

- HoH – Relationship to Head of Household
- Client Enter – Client Entering from Streets, ES, or SH
- Approx Date – Approximate Date Started (if Yes for above)
- Num Times – Number of Times on Streets/ES/SH in Past 3 Years
- Total Mths – Total Number of Months Homeless in Past 3 Years
