

What is the CHAMP?

- The **C**oordinated **H**ousing **A**ssessment and **M**atch **P**lan is the first step in your housing search.
- The CHAMP is a way for agencies to coordinate so that everyone in Knoxville who is homeless will have their housing needs assessed and will have access to all of the programs they are eligible for.
- Once you have completed the CHAMP, you will receive referrals based on your needs.
- Please be aware that completing the CHAMP does not guarantee housing and it is possible that you may not be eligible for any programs.

What happens after I take the CHAMP?

- If you are eligible for a program, you will receive a referral.
- The program might be at the same agency where you completed your CHAMP, but it might be somewhere else.
- Once the program you are referred to has an opening, someone from the agency will contact you directly to schedule an intake
- After you have completed the intake and are enrolled in the program, you will work with a case manager to find housing.
